  - Valid passports and ID
  - Birth certificates
  - Proof of relationship (chat history, photos, letters, call logs, etc.)
  - Affidavit of support from you (showing your financial stability)
  - Japanese family registration (Koseki Tohon) translated into English and notarized
- **Translation and notarization.** All Japanese documents must be officially translated by a certified translator and often notarized. Some states also require an apostille.
- **U.S. embassy interview.** Your fiancée may need to attend an in-person interview at the U.S. embassy in Tokyo or Osaka. It's crucial your stories align and you can prove your relationship is real.
- **Legal marriage in Japan first?** Some couples choose to marry in Japan first and then apply for a CR-1 spouse visa. This process takes longer than the K-1 but allows the spouse to enter the U.S. as a permanent resident.
- **Hire an immigration attorney.** This isn't mandatory, but if you're unfamiliar with immigration law or have a complex background (like prior marriages), a legal expert can                      prevent                      frustrating                      delays.

Remember: this is not just a bureaucratic process—it's a transition for both of you. Allow time for adjustment, emotional ups and downs, and logistical hurdles. But with consistent effort and mutual care, you'll build not just a cross-border relationship but a real partnership.
